


FIG 1: Frequency and Percentage distribution of student participants Grades on World Mental Health Day Program (n = 90)




FIG 2: Frequency and Percentage Distribution of Faculty Grades on World Mental Health Day Program (n=60)




Fig: 3 Frequency and percentage distribution of Feedback grades on World Mental Health Day Program (n = 150)

The total student participants for the program were 90. In the pretest, the score was as follows: 5% A+, 6% A, 58%, B+, 20% B, 11% C and in the post test, the grade has improved such as 73% A+, 13% as A, 4% as B+, and there are no participants in the C & D grade.

Out of the 60 faculty participants, the pretest score was 20% as A+, 63% as A, 17% as B+, and no participants with B, C, and D grade. But in the posttest, the knowledge grade has improved as 87% - A+, 13% - A and no participants in rest of the grades. This reveals that the program was highly effective and useful for the participants.

The feedback analysis shows 72% as excellent, 25% as very good and 3% as good and this indicates that the Program feedback grade is extremely good.
