
Later, the session was open for an open discussion around 15-20 minutes and the participants were clarified their doubts. Felicitation of the speaker and a photo session was followed in a while.















The total student participants for the program were 92. In the pretest, the score was as follows: 5% A+, 5% A, 11% B+, 20% B, 25% C and 32% D and in the post test, the grade has improved such as 50 as A+, 26 as A, 17 as B+, 5 as B, and there are no participants in the C & D grade.

Out of the 60 faculty participants, the pretest score was 12% as A+, 13% as A, 30% as B+, 20% as B, 25% as C, and no participants with D grade. But in the posttest, the knowledge grade has improved as 80% - A+, 20% - A, and no participants in rest of the grades. This reveals that Nurse Led Heart Failure Management program was highly effective and useful for the participants.

The feedback analysis shows 87% as excellent, 10% as very good and 3% as good and this indicates that the Program feedback grade is extremely good.
