Table-1: shows frequency and percentage distribution of level of knowledge among participants, out of 100 participants in pre test, 10 (10%) were having A grade knowledge 16 (16%) were having B grade knowledge 34 (34%) were having C grade knowledge 40 (40%) were having D grade knowledge. Where as in post test, 44 (44%) were having A+ grade knowledge, 32 (32%) were having A grade knowledge, 24(24%) were having B grade knowledge.







Fig-1: Percentage distribution of Comparison of Pre Test & Post Test Scores among participants






Fig-2: FEEDBACK ANALYSIS AMONG PARTICIPENTS
