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4.2.4 DISCRIPTION OF COMMUNITY BASED TEACHING LEARNING ACTIVITIES

Narayana College of Nursing is focused on fostering and strengthening the relationship of the College with the community towards strengthening the individuals, families, and the community. Students are trained in the areas of family assessment and community assessment to identify the health problems of people living in the community. Students are further trained to make referrals for people identified to have problems and to give health education with an emphasis on primary prevention. Community Health Nursing Department is a hub for individuals, families, communities to proffer preventive, promotive, rehabilitative, curative aspects. Community health nurses make a difference to understand the needs of a society's inhabitants. The department has been conducting morbidity clinics at Venkatachalam since 2002 and observes all the National Health days by conducting Screening services, organizing camps based on the needs of the Community, and also performing various forms of health education programs. The department of Community Health Nursing has Core competencies in Providing need-based care to the individual, family, and community at adopted villages as Dakkilivaripalem and Saraswathi Nagar, every month conducting special programsfield of Community and also Coordinating with other departments of Narayana Medical college and hospitals, Narayana Dental hospital. The departmentprovides Comprehensive family-centered nursing care to the families, clients such as antenatal, postnatal's, newborns, children under five



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years, school-age children and adolescents with basic illness, adults with communicable diseases such as tuberculosis, leprosy, etc., non-communicable diseases such as diabetes, hypertension, cardiac conditions, epilepsy, obesity, and psychiatric conditions are identified and referred to territory hospital Family folder system is followed to ensure continuity of home care and documentation. Families are assessed and educated on appropriate health care. The nursing students are posted along with the staff and Nursing supervisors for home visits, clinics, and special programs like pulse polio in order to gain experience and also to complete the clinical requirements and learn about Urban and Rural Health Programmes. school health program every year, the students will assess for health problems. And the children are referred. Health Education is given to the children and School teachers regarding a few health tips and other control of communicable diseases. Department of Child Health Nursing and obstetrics celebrateBreastfeedingweek on August First week every year.and rallies on different national and international awareness days were observed and safe drinking water, environmental day programs and plantation, clearing of garbage, and health education on safe disposal are regular programs by the college, and college will coordinate with the SwatchBharatprograms and Jala Shakthi Abyan in that testing the water to the Dekkalivaripalem was taken as the initial step by the college.
