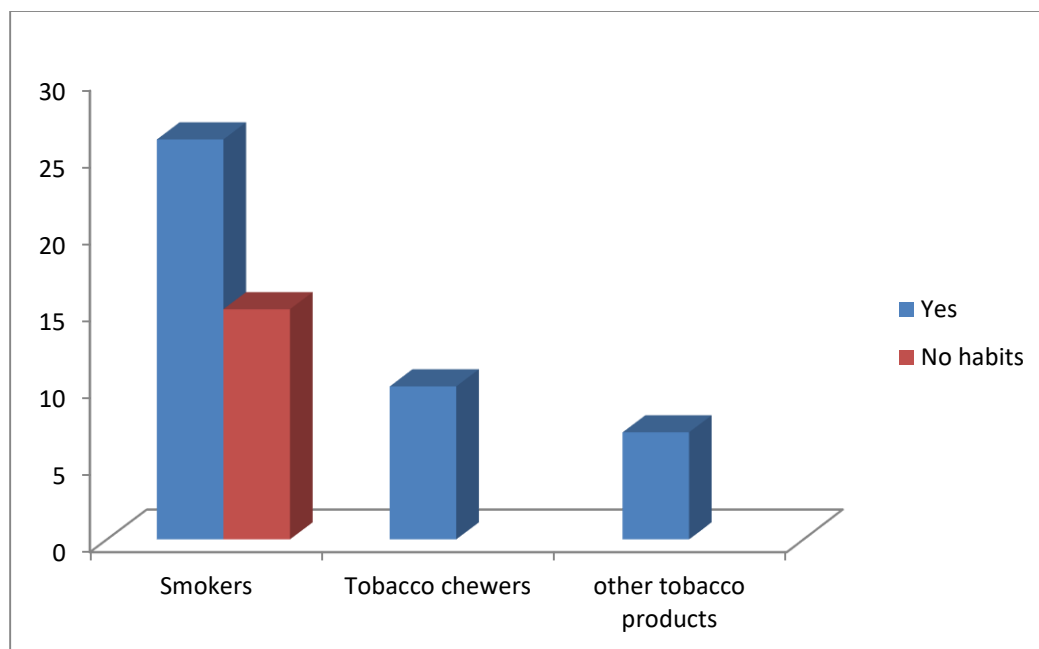


WORLD NO TOBACCO DAY- 2018
