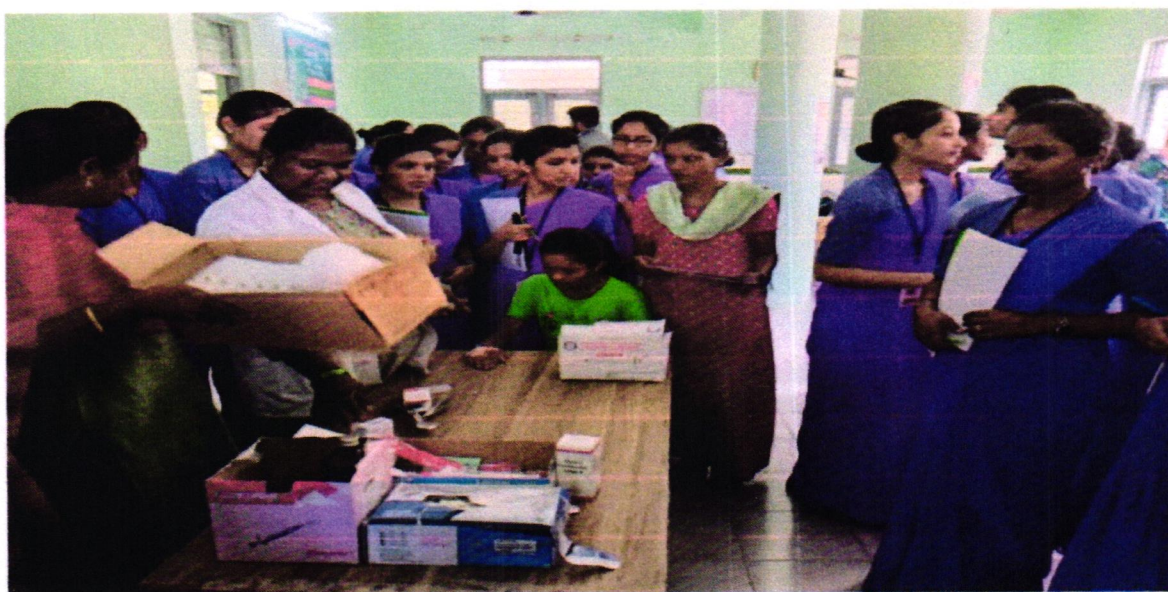

Educational Session on Rabies Vaccination for Pets



Report on Menstrual hygiene Awareness Program
