#### REPORT ON FILARIA CONTROL PROGRAM

An extension activity on the Filaria Control Program was organized on 11/11/2022 by Narayana College of Nursing, Venkatachalam, Nellore, with the aim of creating awareness about lymphatic filariasis and promoting preventive health practices in the community. The program was conducted in collaboration with local health authorities and actively involved 50 nursing students and 4 faculty members from the Department of Community Health Nursing. A total of 52 community members participated in the event, which included health education sessions, distribution of IEC (Information, Education, and Communication) materials, and demonstrations on mosquito breeding prevention. The activity emphasized the importance of drug compliance and encouraged community involvement in filaria control. The program successfully enhanced public understanding of the disease and provided students with valuable field-based learning experience.


