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With regard to the level of knowledge on sample Innovation in Nursing among participants, the pretest results shows that 17(10) scored "A" grade, 16 (9%) participants scored "B+" grade, 28 (16%) participants scored "B" grade, 43(26%)scored "C", D grade scored 40(22%) and no participants scored A+. While in the post test, the knowledge level improved as 111(61%)participants scored "A+" grade, 26(14%) scored "A" grade, and 27(16%) of participants scored "B+" grade, 16(9%)Scored and there was no participants in, C and Dgrades. The results indicate that participants level of knowledge on Innovation I Nursing writing has increased and participants has benefited from the programme.




Fig:1 Distribution of participants Grades on Seminar on Innovation in Nursing (N=180)







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Fig 4: Distribution of Feedback Analysis of the Seminar on Innovation in Nursing (N=180)

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




Fig:2 Distribution of Faculty Grades on Seminar on Innovation in
