




Fig. No 1: Percentage distribution of level of knowledge




Figure: 2 Feedback analysis.




Figure :1 Presentation on heart functions, DASH and exercises for healthy heart function.




Figure: 3 Blood Pressure Monitoring




Figure: 4 weight checking


