


Fig:1 Percentage Distribution of Salutation of participants




Fig :2 Percentage Distribution of the Webinar Met Your Expectation:




Fig :3 Percentage distribution of resource speakers enhanced your interest in the topic




Fig :4 Percentage distribution of coverage of the topic:




Fig: 5 Percentage Distribution of do You Face Any technical difficulties during the Webinar:




Fig:6 Percentage distribution of overall rating of the webinar:
