
At 11am to 12pm Dr. Subramanian has given lecture on research and importance of Research in education.

With regard to the level of knowledge on workshop on education care and research among participants, the pretest results shows that 3(5.26) scored "A" grade, 10(17.54%) participants scored "B+" grade, 24 (42.1%) participants scored "B" grade, 12(21.5%)scored C grade, 8 (14.03 %) scored D grade, While in the post test, the knowledge level improved as 31(54.3 %) participants scored "A+" grade, 26 (45.6%) scored "A" grade and there was no participants in B+, B, C and D grades.

The results indicate that participants level of knowledge on education care and research has enhanced the level of knowledge.




FIG: 1 Percentage distribution of knowledge in pretest and post test.

Table No; 2 Depicts that feedback analysis of workshop on bioethics among participants 61% opted excellent, 36% chosen very good very few opted Good.






FIG no. 2: Frequency distribution of feedback analysis among participants
