MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

By and Between

NARAYANA COLLEGE OF NURSING, CHINTHAREDDYPALEM, NELLORE

AND

INDIAN REDCROSS SOCIETY - CANCER HOSPITAL, PODALAKUR ROAD,
NELLORE

This Memorandum of Understanding (Agreement) is made and entered into by Narayana College of Nursing located in Chinthareddypalem, Nellore and by the Indian Red Cross Society, Cancer Hospital located at Podalakur Road, Nellore.

RECITALS

Whereas the institutions are linked by common academic and healthcare interests;

Whereas the institutions wish to enable cooperation and exchange in all academic and healthcare areas of mutual interests; and

Whereas the institutions wish to develop the basis for better understanding and utilizing the faculty and facilities available in both the institutions;

Therefore, in consideration of their mutual interests and the covenants set forth herein, the institutions agree as follows:

ARTICLE 1

PURPOSE AND SCOPE OF THE AGREEMENT

1.01 **Purpose.** The purposes of this agreement include, but are not limited to the following:

- a) The exchange of students;
- b) Development and carrying out of collaborative projects;
- c) Organizing joint academic and scientific activities such as courses, conferences, seminars, symposia, or lectures;
- d) Exchange of research and teaching personnel;
- e) Exchange of publications and other materials of common interest.

1.02 **Scope.** Cooperative projects under this agreement may include any of the academic disciplines represented at either of the institutions.

ARTICLE 2

PROPOSED ACTIVITIES PURSUANT TO THE AGREEMENT

2.01 **Institutional Appointees.** In order to carry out and fulfill the aims of this agreement, each institution will appoint an appropriate person at each of their campuses to coordinate the development and conduct of joint activities. Through this contact person, either institution may initiate proposals for activities under this agreement. The contact person will additionally be responsible for evaluation of activities under this agreement according to the practices of their respective institutions.

2.02 **Supplemental Agreements.** Activities the institutions mutually agree to undertake are subject to further agreement of the institutions & must be set forth in supplemental agreement signed by authorized representatives of each institution. Supplemental agreements should include specific details of the agreed upon activity, including items such as: (a) elaboration of responsibilities of each institution for the agreed upon activity; (b) schedules for specific activities; (c) budgets & sources of financing for each activity; (d) any other items necessary for efficient conduct of the activity and (e) any other items necessary to meet the legal and policy requirements of each institution. Supplemental agreements are subject to approval by each institution according to the normal policies & procedures governing the types of activities proposed therein.

ARTICLE 3

TERM AND TERMINATION

3.01 **Term.** This agreement shall take effect upon signature by both institutions and, unless terminated earlier shall continue for a period of four years from the date of signing this document by the authorities of both Institutions.

3.02 **Extension.** This agreement maybe extended by mutual agreement of both institutions in writing and signed by the Head/In charge of both Institutions.

3.03 **Termination.** This agreement may be terminated at any time by either institution after giving written notice of the same to the other institution. Any Supplemental agreements entered into by the institutions maybe continued or terminated at termination of this M.O.U. and specific details of the same must be mentioned in the termination notice along with reasons for the termination.

ARTICLE 4

MISCELLANEOUS

4.01 **Recognition.** Narayana College of Nursing is a recognized nursing Training centre by the Indian Nursing Council, New Delhi and by the Dr. Y. S. R. University of Health Sciences of Andhra Pradesh.

4.02 The post graduate students in the specialty of Oral Medicine and Radiology & in the specialty of Oral & Maxillofacial Surgery may be posted to the Indian Red Cross Society Cancer Hospital to learn diagnostic & therapeutic skills in management of oral cancer patients with information to & approval of Indian Red Cross Society Cancer Hospital.

5.01 **Jurisdiction.** The legal jurisdiction of this agreement shall be interpreted and enforced within Nellore, State of Andhra Pradesh, India. Any claims arising out of this agreement shall be subject to the jurisdiction of Civil Court of Nellore.

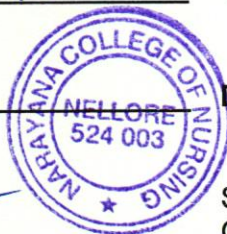
